



## WRITE ABOUT IT

Select one of the following prompts. Then write a five paragraph essay about the artwork(s) you selected. Feel free to use the provided writing structure to help organize your own essay.

Use information from your “What do you see?” and “What do you think?” worksheets to review your ideas as you write.

### **PROMPT 1 / Compare & Contrast**

Write an essay that compares and contrasts two works of art from different artists. Use the Artist Fact Sheets and other resources provided to cite information in your writing.

### **PROMPT 2 / Narrative Essay**

Write a creative narrative five essay inspired by your selected artwork and the information you have about its materials and the artist. Incorporate narrative techniques, such as dialogue, pacing, and description, to develop the story.

### **PROMPT 3 / Informative Essay**

Write an essay that examines your selected artwork. Include a description of the piece, information about the artist, and an analysis of the artwork’s meaning. Use the Artist Fact Sheets and other resources provided to cite information in your writing

## **ESSAY ORGANIZATION**

### **Paragraph 1 / WOW Introduction & Thesis Statement**

Develop an exciting introduction that will hook your reader. Introduce your thesis statement and outline 3-4 main ideas that respond to the essay prompt. Remember to include the name of the artist, the title of the piece, and a description of the work.

### **Paragraph 2- 4 / Main Ideas**

Explain your main ideas from your thesis statement in three body paragraphs. Include details and offer support for your statements. Remember to use transition phrases between paragraphs to enhance your writing.

### **Paragraph 5 / Conclusion**

Restate your thesis statement and summarize your main ideas. Develop a unique ending to wrap up the essay for the reader.
